2010 Workshops at Picket Fence Fabrics

You may register for workshops in person or by phone. Payment must be made at time of registration. Cash, cheque, Interac Visa and MasterCard are accepted. GST is not included in workshop prices. We are happy to pencil you in for a workshop but registration is only confirmed with payment of workshop fee. There is no refund or transfer of workshop fee unless we receive 7 days notice. If a workshop is cancelled by Picket Fence Fabrics you are entitled to a full refund. Please note in case of inclement weather or illness classes may be rescheduled. Every effort will be made to accommodate your schedule when choosing a new date.

We make every effort to provide a complete supply list for the workshops but sometimes, needed items are inadvertently left off the list. We will provide tools for your use if an item was left off the supply list and you do not have it with you.

OPEN CLASSROOM Our classroom is your classroom. Do you want to finish your works-in-progress? We have set aside January 12, 26, February 9, 23, March 9, 23, April 13, 27 (Tuesdays) for Open Classroom from 10 – 4.
